Along the way, the operator gets real-time feedback on piecework earnings, percentage of goal, and other incentive-related information. The ability to view how much is being earned each hour is a very effective incentive, reducing downtime and improving productivity. **BlueCherry®** Shop Floor Control also displays complete, up to the minute production status to line managers. Shortfalls in one operation can be easily spotted and the system can recommend which employee to utilize to fix the imbalance based on individual skill sets.
